

# Peppermint Tea Triangle



A top down triangle shawl, so easy to wear no matter the season.

A magical textured leafy stitch pattern throughout for a relaxing make, finished with lacy peaks.

Add a fab fringe and slurp up every drop of the calming Peppermint Tea



## **Materials**

1 x Scheepjes Whirl – Sea Breeze Tease 60% cotton / 40% acrylic

1000 metres

3.5 mm crochet hook

Stitch Marker

Needle for sewing in ends

## Finished shawl size

156 cm x 78 cm

ch chain

sc single crochet dc double crochet

ch-1sp chain space made with 1 ch ch-2sp chain space made with 2 ch

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## Pattern Notes:

Even numbered rows are right side rows.

- The shawl is worked from the top down, stitches increase with each row. The stitches in bold – signify the centre spine of the shawl. The pattern is mirrored either side of the centre ch-2sp
- The stitch count at the end of the row indicates the stitches on one side of the centre ch-2sp only the same quantity of stitches are mirrored on the other side too
- Wet block your shawl using measurements as a guide.

## Special Stitches

#### FPdc:

Front Post double crochet:

Yarn over hook, insert hook from front to back, around the indicated stitch from previous row, and to the front again, yarn over hook, draw yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, pull through remaining 2 loops.

## FP/dc-tog:

Double Crochet 2 stitches together, with the first stitch worked around front post: Yarn over hook, insert hook from front to back, around the indicated stitch from previous row, and to the front again, yarn over hook, draw yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over hook, insert hook into top of next stitch, yarn over hook pull yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, pull through remaining 3 loops

#### dc/FPdc-tog:

Double Crochet 2 stitches together, with the second stitch worked around front post:

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Yarn over hook, insert hook into top of next stitch, yarn over hook pull yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, insert hook from front to back, around the indicated stitch from previous row, and to the front again, yarn over hook, draw yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, pull through remaining 3 loops

### BP/dc-tog:

Double Crochet 2 stitches together, with the first stitch worked around back post: Yarn over hook, insert hook from back to front, around the indicated stitch from previous row, and to the back again, yarn over hook, draw yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over hook, insert hook into top of next stitch, yarn over hook pull yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, pull through remaining 3 loops

#### dc/BPdc-tog:

Double Crochet 2 stitches together, with the second stitch worked around front post: Yarn over hook, insert hook into top of next stitch, yarn over hook pull yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, insert hook from back to front, around the indicated stitch from previous row, and to the back again, yarn over hook, draw yarn through, yarn over hook pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, pull through remaining 3 loops

#### Cluster:

3 dc together in same stitch.

(Yarn over hook, insert hook in indicated stich or ch-sp, yarn over hook, draw yarn through, yarn over hook, pull through 2 loops) 3 times, yarn over hook pull yarn through 4 remaining loops on hook.

Cluster-3: (Cluster, ch 2, Cluster, ch 2, Cluster) in ch-3sp

# **Start**

#### **Set Up Rows**

**Row 1:** into a magic ring work: ch 3 (counts as first dc, now and throughout), dc, ch 1, 2 dc ch 2 (place SM in centre ch-2sp), 2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc. Turn

4 dc, 1 ch-1sp (stitch count – these are the stitches on one side of the centre ch-2sp only – see pattern notes)

**Row 2:** Ch 3, skip dc, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-1sp, skip 2 dc, (dc, ch 2, dc) in centre ch-2sp (move SM to ch-2sp), skip 2 dc, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in ch-1sp, skip dc, dc in last dc (the last dc is the 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from beginning chains from previous row, now and throughout). Turn

8 dc, 1 ch-1sp

**Row 3:** Ch 3, skip next dc, \*(2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, ch 1, skip [dc, ch-1sp, dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc,\* skip 2 dc, (dc, ch 2, dc) in centre ch-2sp (move SM to ch-2sp), skip next 2 dc, repeat from \* to \*, skip next dc, dc in last dc. Turn 10 dc, 3 ch-1sp

**Row 4:** Ch 3, dc in first dc, ch 1, skip 2 dc, \*(2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1sp, ch 1, skip [2 dc, ch-1sp, 2 dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1sp,\* ch 2, skip 3 dc, (dc, ch 2, dc) in centre **ch-2sp** (move SM to ch-2sp), ch 2, skip 3 dc, repeat from \* to \*, ch 1, skip 2 dc, 2 dc in last dc. Turn

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11 dc, 4 ch-1sp, 1 ch-2sp

**Row 5:** Ch 3, (dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in first dc, ch 2, skip [dc, ch-1sp, 2 dc], \*dc in next ch-1sp, (dc in each of next 2 dc, dc in ch-1sp) twice, ch 2\*, skip [2 dc, ch-2sp], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, **ch 2** (move SM to this ch-2sp), (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, 2 dc], repeat from \* to \*, skip [2 dc, ch-1sp, dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in last dc. Turn 15 dc, 2 ch-2sp, 2 ch-1sp

**Row 6:** Ch 3, skip next dc, \*(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in ch-1sp, ch 2, skip [2 dc, ch-2sp], FP/dc-2tog over next 2 dc, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc/FP-2tog over next 2 dc, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, 2 dc] (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in ch-1sp\*, skip 2 dc, (**dc, ch 2, dc) in centre ch-2sp** (move SM to ch-2sp), skip 2 dc, repeat from \* to \*, skip next dc, dc in last dc. Turn 19 dc, 2 ch-2sp, 2 ch-1sp (2tog stitches are counted as one dc)

**Row 7:** Ch 3, skip next dc, \*(2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, ch 1, skip [dc, ch-1sp, dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, ch 2, skip [dc, ch-2sp], BP/dc-2tog over next 2 dc, dc in next dc, dc/BP-2tog over next 2 dc, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, ch 1, skip [dc, ch-1sp, dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc\*, skip 2 dc, **(dc, ch 2, dc) in centre ch-2sp** (move SM to ch-2sp), skip 2 dc, repeat from \* to \*, dc in last dc. Turn 21 dc, 2 ch-2sp, 6 ch-1sp (2tog stitches are counted as one dc)

**Row 8:** Ch 3, dc in first dc, ch 1, skip 2 dc, \*(2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1sp, ch 1, skip [2 dc, ch-1sp, 2 dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1sp, ch 2, skip [2 dc, ch-2sp, dc], FPdc in next dc, ch 2 skip [dc, ch-2sp, 2 dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1sp, ch 1, skip [2 dc, ch-1sp, 2 dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1sp\*, ch 2, skip 3 dc, **(dc, ch 2, dc) in centre ch-2sp** (move



SM to ch-2sp), ch 2, skip 3 dc, repeat from \* to \*, ch 1, skip 2 dc, 2 dc in last dc. Turn 20 dc, 7 ch-1sp, 3 ch-2sp

#### **The Pattern**

Note: the pattern repeat either side of the centre **ch2** is underlined

Row 9: Ch 3, (dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in first dc, ch 2, skip [dc, ch-1sp, 2 dc], dc in next ch-1sp, (dc in each of next 2 dc, dc in ch-1sp) twice, ch 2, skip [2 dc, ch-2sp], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, \*ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, 2 dc], dc in next ch-1sp, (dc in each of next 2 dc, dc in ch-1sp) twice, ch 2, skip [2 dc, ch-2sp], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, repeat from \* to SM, ch 2 (move SM to this ch-2sp), (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, 2 dc], dc in next ch-1sp, (dc in each of next 2 dc, dc in ch-1sp) twice, ch 2, \*\*skip [2 dc, ch-2sp], (2 dc, ch

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1, 2 dc) in next dc, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, 2 dc], dc in next ch-1sp, (dc in each of next 2 dc, dc in ch-1sp) twice, ch 2, repeat from \*\* across to last [2 dc, ch-1sp, 2 dc], skip [2 dc, ch-1sp, dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in last dc. Turn 26 dc, 4 ch-2sp, 3 ch-1sp

Row 10: Ch 3, skip next dc, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in ch-1sp, \*ch 2, skip [2 dc, ch-2sp], FP/dc-2tog over next 2 dc, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc/FP-2tog over next 2 dc, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, 2 dc] (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in ch-1sp, repeat from \* across to 2 dc before SM, skip 2 dc, (dc, ch 2, dc) in centre ch-2sp (move SM to ch-2sp), skip 2 dc, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in ch-1sp, \*\*ch 2, skip [2 dc, ch-2sp], FP/dc-2tog over next 2 dc, dc in each of next 3 dc, dc/FP-2tog over next 2 dc, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, 2 dc] (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in ch-1sp, repeat from \*\* to last 2 dc, skip next dc, dc in last dc. Turn

30 dc, 4 ch-2sp, 3 ch-1sp (2tog stitches are counted as one dc)

Row 11: Ch 3, \*skip next dc, (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, ch 1, skip [dc, ch-1sp, dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, \*ch 2, skip [dc, ch-2sp], BP/dc-2tog over next 2 dc, dc in next dc, dc/BP-2tog over next 2 dc, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, ch 1, skip [dc, ch-1sp, dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, repeat from \* across to 2 dc before SM, skip 2 dc, (dc, ch 2, dc) in centre ch-2sp (move SM to ch-2sp), skip 2 dc, (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, ch 1, skip [dc, ch-1sp, dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, \*\*ch 2, skip [dc, ch-2sp], BP/dc-2tog over next 2 dc, dc in next dc, dc/BP-2tog over next 2 dc, ch 2, skip [ch-2sp, dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc, ch 1, skip [dc, ch-1sp, dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next dc repeat from \*\* across to last 2 dc, skip dc, dc in last dc. Turn 32 dc, 4 ch-2sp, 9 ch-1sp (2tog stitches are counted as one dc)

**Row 12:** Ch 3, dc in first dc, ch 1, skip 2 dc, (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1sp, ch 1, skip [2 dc, ch-1sp, 2 dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1sp, \*ch 2, skip [2 dc, ch-2sp, dc], FPdc in next dc, ch 2 skip [dc, ch-2sp, 2 dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1sp, ch 1, skip [2 dc, ch-1sp, 2 dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc)in next ch-1sp, repeat from \* across to 3 dc before SM, ch 2, skip 3 dc, (dc, ch 2, dc) in centre ch-2sp (move SM to ch-2sp), skip 3 dc, (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1sp, ch 1, skip [2 dc, ch-1sp, 2 dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1sp, \*\*ch 2, skip [2 dc, ch-2sp, dc], FPdc in next dc, ch 2 skip [dc, ch-2sp, 2 dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1sp, ch 1, skip [2 dc, ch-1sp, 2 dc], (2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next ch-1sp, repeat from \*\* across to last 3 dc, ch 1, skip 2 dc, 2 dc in last dc. Turn 29 dc, 10 ch-1sp, 5 ch-2sp

Repeat Rows 9 – 12 as many times as you wish depending on the size shawl you'd like

# **Border**

Row 1: Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), dc in first dc, skip [dc, ch-1sp, dc], (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, skip [ch-1sp, 2 dc], (dc, ch 3, dc) into next ch (see pattern notes), skip [2 dc, ch-1sp], (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, skip [dc, ch-2sp], (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, \*skip [ch-2sp, dc], (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, skip [ch-1sp, 2 dc], (dc, ch 3, dc) into next ch, skip [2 dc, ch-1sp], (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, skip [dc, ch-2sp], (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, skip [ch-1sp, 2 dc], (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, skip [ch-1sp, 2 dc], (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, skip [dc, ch-2sp], (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, skip [dc, ch-2sp], (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, skip [ch-1sp, 2 dc], (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, skip [ch-1sp, 2 dc], (dc, ch 3, dc) in next ch, skip [2 dc, ch-1sp], (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, repeat from \*\* across to last [dc, ch-1sp, 2 dc], skip [dc, ch-1sp, dc] (dc, ch 3, dc) in last dc. Turn.



Row 2: Ch 3, Cluster-3 (see Special Stitches) in ch-3sp, \*ch 1, skip 2 dc, sc in next ch-3sp, ch 1, skip 2 dc, Cluster-3 in next ch-3sp, repeat from \* to dc before SM, skip dc, (dc, ch 2, dc) in centre ch-sp (move SM to ch-2sp), skip dc, Cluster-3 in next ch-3sp, \*\*ch 1, skip 2 dc, sc in next ch-3sp, ch 1, skip 2 dc, Cluster-3 in next ch-3sp, repeat from \*\* to last dc, dc in last dc. Turn

**Row 3:** ch 1(does not count as a stitch), sc in 1<sup>st</sup> dc, ch 5, sc in middle cluster, \*ch 5, sc in next sc, ch 5, sc in middle cluster, repeat across to centre ch-2sp, **(dc, ch 6, dc)** in centre ch-sp, ch 5, sc in middle cluster, \*\*ch 5, sc in next sc, ch 5, sc in middle cluster, repeat from \*\* across to last cluster, ch 5, sc in last dc. Turn

**Round 4:** ch 1 (does not count as a stitch), (sc, ch 3, sc) in 1<sup>st</sup> sc, 5 sc in ch-5-loop, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next sc, 5 sc in ch-5-loop, \*skip sc, 5 sc in next ch-5-loop, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next sc, 5 sc in next ch-5-loop, repeat from \* dc before centre ch-2sp, sc in next dc, **(4 dc, ch3, 4dc) in centre ch-6-loop,** sc in next dc, 5 sc in ch-5-loop, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next sc, 5 sc in ch-5-loop, \*\*skip sc, 5 sc in next ch-5-loop, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next sc, 5 sc in next ch-5-loop, repeat from \*\* to last sc, (sc, ch 3, sc) in last sc. Fasten Off

# **Finishing**

Sew in all ends

For best results, block the shawl using measurements as a guide.

#### Add a fringe



Use 7 x strands cut to approx. 18 cm for each fringe

Use some card to wrap the yarn around to save measuring each time.

Keep the strands folded







With your fingers, open up the loop created grab the strands and pull through

Pull the strands through.

Place the crochet hook through the stitch or the ch-1sp from top to bottom, grab the strands with the hook.








Pull to tighten.

Trim the fringe to neaten the edges once all have been added.
